

During the outage, the old machine 'hpcwoods' was decommissioned and replaced with a new machine, also called hpcwoods. All files and settings were transferred from the old machine to the new. However, your SSH client will detect that the new hpcwoods is a different machine than the hpcwoods you connected to in the past. This document describes the error messages you will see and the procedures for fixing them.

## CONNECTING TO HPCWOODS FROM WINDOWS SSH CLIENTS

Open the connection to hpcwoods.olemiss.edu as usual:  
A warning message will appear in a new dialog box:  
The warning is, in this case, perfectly normal. Click Yes.

Another notification will appear in a second dialog box.  
Click Yes.

The next dialog box will ask for your "Authentication Response" and give a window to type in.  
Type your password in the window and click OK or strike the Enter key.

A final dialog box appears and prompts you to "Enter Your Authentication Response", but has only buttons:  
Click OK.

You should be connected. Please be sure that all your files and settings are as you left them.

## CONNECTING TO HPCWOODS FROM MAC or UNIX/LINUX CLIENTS

You may fail to connect with something like the following message:

In this case, simply edit the indicated "known\_hosts" file, remove the current entry for hpcwoods, and reconnect. Upon successfully connection, the correct hpcwoods information will automatically be added to your known\_hosts file.
